The book has been published by Gerhard Steidl, the legendary book maker. This was one of David's last projects before his death in June 2018.

"I wanted to meet people who had done crime or been accused of it and punished. I wanted to meet them not as incarcerated criminals, but paroled or free. I wanted to photograph them not in re-enactment of crime, but in stillness at the scene of crime. And I wanted to record whatever they wished to tell me of their life. And do this not as a journalist or activist, but simply out of a wish to know." - David Goldblatt
